

# 2012 Race for the Arts

## How schools can earn portion(s)



To ensure proper credit, be sure to include the name of the school and department (music, art, track team, etc) you are participating for on all forms. All forms are available for download from the website, [www.RaceForTheArts.org](http://www.RaceForTheArts.org)

### 1. Runners and walkers

For every 10 people registered for the same school in the walk and/or the race earn 1 portion of the proceeds.

### 2. Volunteers

For every 10 volunteers registered for the same school, by February 10, 2012, earn 1 portion of the proceeds. A **maximum of 25 volunteers** per school will be credited.

Volunteers must check in on race day at the Volunteer Registration area between 4:30AM & 5:30AM, depending on assignment and checkout at the Volunteer Registration area at 10:30AM to receive school credit and volunteer hours. Student volunteers will also earn 6 volunteer credit hours at the end of clean up.

**Volunteers** must attend a **Mandatory Assignment Meeting for training** at the American German Club on Sunday, February 19 from 5:00-6:00 PM. Training will be provided by each area chair and will start at 5PM sharp. Please be on time.

### 3. Combination of Runners/Walkers and Volunteers:

Any combination that equals 10 persons will earn your school one portion, not to exceed volunteer maximum noted above.

### 4. Banner/Mural Contest

1 Banner or mural entry per school earns ½ portion of the proceeds. **To qualify the banner/mural and art teacher must be present at the race on race day by 6 AM to display mural and volunteer.**

### 5. Shoe Contest

Each 5 shoes entered earns 1 portion of the proceeds. For contest rules please see your art teacher.

### 6. Live Museum

For every 10 students registered from the same school that wear or hold original artwork during the race on the race route and then also walk around with their artwork at the pavilion earn 1 portion of the proceeds. Live Museum entries must check in and out at the volunteer area when they arrive on site. The registration requirements are listed on the volunteer form.

### 7. Entertainers Group

Every performing group earns 1 portion of the proceeds whether they have been assigned to perform at the pavilion or on the race route.

### 8. Fund Raisers

Students may collect donations for Race for the Arts and turn donations in on race day. The student that raises the most money will earn an extra ½ portion for the school and department designated on their pledge form.

### 9. T-shirt Art Contest
